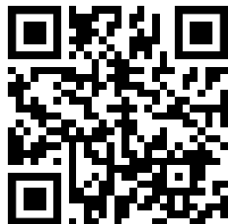

811 Call Before You Dig

Planning any digging? Whether you're planting a tree or starting construction, taking the right steps beforehand keeps you safe and protects underground utilities. Notify your utilities before you dig by calling 811.

What's New

Here are some projects the District is currently working on:

Meter Upgrading: A cost share, Bureau of Reclamation grant is helping fund the upgrading of 90% of the District's residential meters to cellular meters for water and energy efficiency. Projected completion: Fall 2026

Highland Reservoir: Interior cleaning and resealing to extend reservoir's service life. Projected completion: Spring 2026

Fuel Tank Installation: A large diesel fuel tank will be installed to allow for longer run times of the District's generator during power outages. Projected completion: Summer 2026

Pump House Plumbing: Meters and plumbing in the Pump House will be upsized to ease pumping restrictions and extend service life. Projected completion: Spring 2027

Backflow Testing

Spring is here and that means it's also backflow testing season. Backflow test results are due to the District by **July 15, 2026**. If you don't have a cross-connection, notify the District in writing that no backflow test is needed. Your compliance helps protect our potable water.

Recently Completed Projects

2024: Expansion of Pump House to meet safety codes and allow for critical part replacements. Funded by the 10-year tax levy and a \$24,000 grant from Idaho DEQ.

2024: Installation of a diesel generator for well pump backup power. Was used to power the wells during the power outage this past March. Funded by the 10-year tax levy.

2025: Replacement of two 20+ year old well pumps to maintain reliability and serviceability. Funded by the 10-year tax levy.

The Board meets the fourth Monday of the month at 4pm. Meetings are open to the public and held at the District office. Meeting agendas are posted at the office and on the website.
